



What do I need to know about the territories and volunteers?

Territories

- Each Greg Gannon Canned Food Drive starts with 30 +/- territories.
- Territories have 100-150 houses and are delineated by streets.
- Territory volunteers only collect on the inside street of their territory. (Competition is stiff, this is very important!)
- Territories start in the immediate neighborhoods surrounding the parish/school and span out from there.
- Additional territories can be created as needed.
- Territories outside parish bounds for commuter families can be made as long as they don't overlap with other Greg Gannon Canned Food Drives.
- Families might not get the territory that includes their home.

- We suggest that families work together. It is much more fun, goes faster and collection is more thorough when two families work together.
- This is an event for all ages. We want all members of the family to participate and demonstrate love and service to the community.

- Volunteers can register on the site for territories or to volunteer in general.
- Territory information is also housed on the website.
- You can also use it to communicate with your volunteers and post event information as well as pictures and post event numbers.
